

Burnsville Planning Board  
Special Meeting  
Wednesday, February 22, 2017

The Burnsville Planning Board, with members Harrison Tyner, Kim Simpson, Greg Yuziuk, Armin Wessel, Woody Ryan, Russell Fox and Randy Banks present held a special meeting on Wednesday, February 22, 2017, in the Town Hall. Also in attendance were town staff members Jon England and Kim Johnson. Harrison Tyner, who presided, called the meeting to order stating the purpose of the meeting was to review and take action on an application for sidewalk dining.

Jon England presented board members with a copy of an application for sidewalk dining from Will Young at the Blind Squirrel. Mr. Young included all required information with the application including a drawing of the desired layout. Jon informed the board members that he had talked with the Burnsville Police Chief and the town's attorney and both agreed that making the pedestrian walkway next to the road and the tables farther from the traffic could cause less liability. Jon had a draft drawing of the alternate plan and board members discussed the new drawing and agreed this plan would work better but did not want to micro manage his entrance and exit points. Armin Wessel made a motion to approve the alternate plan pending the exit points and pedestrian walkway signage, Woody Ryan seconded and all agreed. Jon England will now present this alternate plan to Mr. Young.

Armin Wessel made a motion to adjourn, Kim Simpson seconded, meeting adjourned.
